We are finally seeing some sun in the sky and some green growth after a lot of rain over the months. As Spring is here we also want to take time to reflect on our own community and communities across the world and to express empathy, kindness and hope for change.

Over the past months, we are pleased to report on funding successes and partnerships that have continued to flourish through rewarding creative and cultural collaborations. Here are just a few of the exciting events we have hosted and developed already in 2024.

In January, we held the final event for Pioneers and Places, our National Heritage Lottery Heritage-funded project. In an online conference, we were able to share locally, nationally and internationally the amazing work accomplished over the past 18 months. In February, as part of the Goldsmiths Friday Late programme, our youth dance group and BA (Hons) students performed at the Garden Museum – adjacent to Lambeth Palace – to celebrate the work of Antiguan artist, gardener and radical, Frank Walter. Thanks to additional funding from Lewisham Council for LGBTQ+ History Month we were excited to host 'Dancing in Colour' a screening and discussion with 4 LGBTQ+ dancers of colour. The event was well attended and provided a safe space for open and honest conversation around race, gender and dance.

In March, IRIE! welcomed the local community to 'Drums of Resistance', an exhibition and the unveiling of a Lewisham Maroon Heritage Plaque at Moonshot. The plaque commemorates the Black People's Day of Action, 2nd March 1981 where thousands from the Black community gathered to march for justice for 13 young people who lost their lives in the New Cross Fire. We also remembered the young survivor who died 2 years later and brought the total loss of life to 14. This was funded and supported by the National Lottery Heritage Fund (NHLF), Goldsmiths, University of London and Lewisham Heritage. The event also launched our NHLF-funded 'Talking Drum' project – an exhibition and programme of African and Caribbean drumming sessions to encourage a wider understanding of, and increase engagement with, the heritage and practice of African and Caribbean drumming.

We are excited to have been awarded funds from the Make Moves Fund, a Nike and Spotify initiative to encourage more girls and young women to move through music. We would like to say thank you for their funding, to Arts Council England, National Lottery Community Fund. As well as South London

and Maudsley NHS (SLAM) and Lewisham Local for enabling us to continue to engage across age groups, genders, and communities and to reach new audiences throughout 2024.

I have to ask, have you had a delicious meal or enjoyed free soup as part of our Warm Welcome on Mondays in IRIE!'s Kitchen? Don't forget to complete our feedback form and let us know what you think, and what other activities you would like to see take place at Moonshot.






